

Return to Work Act – For Small Business Employers

The reform to South Australia's workers compensation laws which took place on 1 July 2015 is the most significant change in the last 30 years. Not only has WorkCover SA changed its name (ReturntoWorkSA), the legislation totally replaces the laws we have been familiar with for the last 30 years.

With the introduction of the new *Return to Work Act 2014*, employers <u>must</u> refocus the way they manage their injured workers and be proactive in the recovery and return to work of these workers. The new laws place serious obligations on employers to provide suitable employment to a worker who has suffered an injury and there are significant cost consequences for those who do not comply with this obligation.

This workshop is an introductory session which is aimed at providing an overview of the key changes. You will walk away from the session with a better idea about how you will manage your injured workforce so as to minimise the financial risks to your business while achieving the goal of return to work.
